#### PRELUDE

Please light one (or more) of the candles located on the table in the back of the Chapel. We light these candles as an act of repentance; acknowledging our mortality and sinful nature.

### CALL TO WORSHIP

Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent with a public act of confession. It is here we acknowledge that we have all sinned and fallen short of God's glory, so we repent and return to our loving God. Acutely aware of our failure and frailty, it is here we express our utter reliance of God's saving grace. (BCW: Daily Prayer, "Lent")

### PRAYER OF THE DAY

Almighty God, you despise nothing you have made and you forgive the sins of all who trust in you. Create in us new and contrite hearts, that truly repenting of our sins, and acknowledging our brokenness, we may receive from you, the God of all mercy, full pardon and forgiveness; through your Son, Jesus Christ our redeemer, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

# INVITATION TO OBSERVE A HOLY LENT

# LITANY OF PENITENCE

Holy and merciful God, we confess to you and to one another, and to the whole communion of saints in heaven and on earth, that we have sinned by our own fault in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart, and mind, and strength. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We have not forgiven others as we have been forgiven. Have mercy on us, O God. We have not listened to your call to serve as Christ served us. We have not been true to the mind of Christ. We have grieved your Holy Spirit. Have mercy on us, O God. We confess to you, O God, all our past unfaithfulness: the pride, hypocrisy, and impatience in our lives, we confess to you, O God. Our self-indulgent appetites and ways and our exploitation of other people, we confess to you, O God. Our anger at our own frustration and our envy of those more fortunate than ourselves, we confess to you, O God. Our imperative love of worldly goods and comforts, and our dishonesty in daily life and work, we confess to you, O God. Our negligence in prayer and worship, and our failure to commend the faith that is in us. we confess to you, O God. Accept our repentance, O God, for the wrongs we have done. For our neglect of human need and suffering and our indifference to injustice and cruelty. For all false judgements, for uncharitable thoughts toward our neighbors, and for our prejudice and contempt toward those who differ from us. For our waste and pollution of your creation and our lack of concern for those who come after us. Accept our repentance, O God, and restore us, for your mercy is great. Amen.
